SUMMARY FINDINGS:

No. of Respondents: 58

(90% Confid. Level. + / - 10% Error Band)

The US respondents were 53% of total. South America (other than Brazil) was 9%, China was 7%, all others were less.

- -- 27% of respondents say they receive direct government subsidies.
- -- only 2% of the total said government subsidies keep them in business.
- -- 21% believe government subsidies are necessary for research and development.
- -- 54% believe government research in alternative uses for cellulose creates competitors for the pulp and paper industry.
- -- 25% of respondents say their government provides tariff protection for domestic pulp and paper products.
- -- 42% of respondents said their business was hurt this year by the North American black liquor tax credit.
- -- 93% believe governments should offer tax breaks and research funding to the pulp and paper industry.
